

PUBLIC NOTICE

PLEASE TAKE NOTICE that the Board of Trustees of the Village of Head-of-the-Harbor will hold a public hearing on the 16th day of June, 2010, at 7:00 P.M., at the Village Hall, 500 North Country Road, Head-of-the-Harbor, New York, to consider the adoption of a local law as follows:

**LOCAL LAW NO. (Intro.) #2 OF 2010
A LOCAL LAW AMENDING VILLAGE CODE CHAPTER 38**

BE IT ENACTED BY THE BOARD OF TRUSTEES OF THE VILLAGE OF HEAD-OF-THE-HARBOR AS FOLLOWS:

SECTION 1. PURPOSE.

The purpose of this local law is to update the language in Village Code, Chapter 38, Police Justice, consistent with state law amendments.

SECTION 2. AMENDMENT OF CHAPTER 38.

Chapter 38 is amended to read as follows:

[Police Justice] Justice Court

§ 38-1. Position established.

The office of [Police Justice] Village Justice is hereby established for the Incorporated Village of Head-of-the-Harbor.

[\$ 38-2. Referendum.

This chapter is subject to a permissive referendum, and notice of the adoption thereof is given pursuant to the requirements of § 139 of the Village Law.^{1]}*

* Bracketed language is deleted. Underlined language is new.

SECTION 3. SEQRA.

This is a Type II action under 6 NYCRR § 617.5(c)(20).

SECTION 4. SEVERABILITY.

Should any part or provision of this local law be decided by the courts to be unconstitutional or invalid, such decision shall not affect the validity of the local law as a whole nor any part thereof other than the part so decided to be unconstitutional or invalid.

SECTION 5. EFFECTIVE DATE.

This Local Law shall take effect immediately upon filing with the Secretary of State as provided by law.

All persons in interest will be heard by the Board of Trustees at the public hearing to be held as aforesaid and may appear in person or by representative. The Village Hall is accessible to handicapped persons.
