

PUBLIC NOTICE

PLEASE TAKE NOTICE that the Board of Trustees of the Village of Head-of-the-Harbor will held a public hearing on the 16th day of December, 2009, at 7:00 P.M., at the Village Hall, 500 North Country Road, Head-of-the-Harbor, New York, and duly adopted a local law as follows:

LOCAL LAW NO. 6 OF 2009

A LOCAL LAW AMENDING § 116-5(A) OF THE VILLAGE CODE TO REGULATE AND LIMIT NOISES

SECTION 1. PURPOSE.

The purpose of this local law is to address noises disturbing to the peace and quiet of the community when used excessively.

SECTION 2. AMENDMENT OF § 116-5(A).

Section 116-5(A) is amended to read as follows:

Domestic power tools, lawn mowers and agricultural equipment when operated with a muffler between 8:00 a.m. and 8:00 p.m. on weekdays and from 9:00 a.m. to ~~[8:00]~~ 5:00* p.m. on weekends and holidays, provided that they are not being operated for recreational purposes and produce no more than 85 dB(A) at a distance of 50 feet from the source and provided further that such operation not exceed four (4) hours on any weekend day or holiday and provided further any such four (4) hours on a Sunday shall be limited to between 11:00 AM and 3:00 PM.

SECTION 3 SEVERABILITY.

Should any part or provision of this local law be decided by the courts to be unconstitutional or invalid, such decision shall not affect the validity of the local law as a whole nor any part thereof other than the part so decided to be unconstitutional or invalid.

SECTION 4 EFFECTIVE DATE.

This Local Law shall take effect immediately upon filing with the Secretary of State as provided by law.
