A work session of the Board of Trustees of the Incorporated Village of Head-of-the-Harbor was held on Wednesday, February 7, 2018 at 7 PM at the Village Hall located at 500 North Country Rd., St. James, NY 11780. Those present were the following members Mayor Douglas A. Dahlgard, Deputy Mayor Daniel W. White, Trustees Judith C. Ogden, L. Gordon Van Vechten and Jeffrey D. Fischer. - It was, upon motion by Trustee Ogden, second by Trustee White and unanimously adopted: **RESOLUTION # 201-17**

**WHEREAS**, the Suffolk County Water Quality Protection and Restoration Program (WQPRP) provides grant funding on a competitive basis for water quality projects; and

**WHEREAS**, the Village of Head of the Harbor has an interest in improving and protecting water quality within the Village; and

**WHEREAS**, the Village of Head of the Harbor wishes to submit an application for funding for consideration by the Suffolk County WQPRP Review Committee under its 2018 funding round; and

**WHEREAS**, the proposed project, titled "50 ACRE ROAD STORMWATER GREEN INFRASTRUCTURE IMPROVEMENTS" will provide for sustainment of the Village; and **WHEREAS**, the Village Board authorizes the submission of this application and the Village will make a SEQRA determination on the proposed project; and

**WHEREAS**, the total project cost is estimated at  $\pm$ \$475,000, and an amount not to exceed \$200,000 is requested from the WQPRP, the maximum allowable under WQPRP guidelines; **NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED**, that the Village Board of the Village of Head of the Harbor hereby states its support of the 50 ACRE ROAD STORMWATER GREEN INFRASTRUCTURE IMPROVEMENTS project; and be it further

**RESOLVED**, that the Village will support that portion of the project cost that is not supported by Suffolk County, or ±\$275,000, or at minimum 50% of the total project cost including in-kind services, should the project receive funding approval from the County; and be it further **RESOLVED**, that the Village Board authorizes the Mayor, or his designee, to sign any and all necessary documents pertaining to the project, including but not limited to an inter-municipal agreement, subject to review and approval of the Village Attorney, and to participate in the above referenced program.
