The following items were discussed:

- **Nissequogue Fire Department Exterior Renovation Project.**  
Possible repairs to the exterior of the building were discussed including: garage doors, roof, siding windows, retaining wall and lighting. Building Inspector, Joseph Arico and Village Engineer, Daniel Falasco will review the exterior of the Nissequogue Fire Department building and make a recommendation to the Board of Trustees concerning the scope and cost of the repairs.

- **Nissequogue Pumper Truck 4-5-2.**  
The replacement of 4-5-2 including projected cost and timeline for replacement were deliberated.
- **Water Rescue Boat**  
Discussion continued concerning the Department's need for a water rescue boat. A potential suggestion was made for the purchase of a Go Devil Water Rescue Boat with an approximate cost of \$25,000.00.
- **Chief's Vehicle**  
The Department's need for a new chief's vehicle was examined. A suggestion was made to purchase a pick-up truck with a cab at an approximate cost of \$45,000.00
- **Chief's Succession Plan**  
The creation of a plan for the progression of NQFD volunteers from line officers to chief positions was considered.
