A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE PURCHASE OF A VEHICLE FOR USE IN AND FOR THE FIRE DEPARTMENT IN THE VILLAGE OF NISSEQUOGUE, SUFFOLK COUNTY, NEW YORK, AT A MAXIMUM ESTIMATED COST OF \$63,700 AND AUTHORIZING THE ISSUANCE OF \$50,000 SERIAL BONDS OF SAID VILLAGE TO PAY A PART OF THE COST THEREOF.
