

PUBLIC NOTICE

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that on September 21, 2021, the Board of Trustees of the Incorporated Village of Nissequogue, Suffolk County, New York, adopted Local Law No. 3 of 2021, a local law adding a new Chapter 79a to Part II of the Code of the Village of Nissequogue to address registration and maintenance of vacant and abandoned property with foreclosed or foreclosing mortgages. The local law added a new Chapter 79a, "Registration and Maintenance of Vacant and Abandoned Property," which sets forth the inspection, registration, maintenance, and security requirements for vacant, abandoned, foreclosing or foreclosed property within the Village, as well as the penalties for failure to comply with the requirements of the Chapter and the authority of the Village to take action to protect the public health, safety and welfare and to enforce the requirements of the Chapter. Copies of said proposed Local Law are available for review at Village Hall.
